Jeff Coleman, President

- Cathy made a motion to approve April minutes, Marv seconded, all in favor, motion approved.

- The fields are being lined a lot more often so we're going through a lot more paint.

- Reviewed our contract with Venancio Gonzalez. Cathy made a motion to revise the contract effective May 1, 2014 that new contract will cover 10 months, February through November, for \$1200/month plus tax, Jak seconded, all in favor, motion passed. We need new fuel barrels. Venancio will ask Wilcox and Flegal to replace them.

- Snack shack will go up in the middle of the fields this weekend. He requested to leave it parked on the blacktop until July 2<sup>nd</sup>.

New business

- Jeff proposed hosting a U10 and under recreational tournament to be held sometime in June. He will type up a proposal and email it to the board.
