Jeff Coleman, President

- Cathy made a motion to approve July minutes, Bob seconded, all in favor, motion passed.
- Seth made a motion to approve July financials, Jenn seconded, all in favor, motion passed.

- Would like to change the field layout sign.
- The lock to access the room behind the bathrooms is now keyed to match the bathrooms.
- Still shopping for a new gator. Ours is fixed enough to work for the time being while we wait for a good deal.
- Field 9 fencing is purchased and sitting in the breezeway.
- Fixed two sprinkler leaks.
- We need to get a spider box with a 50 ft. cord so we can have 210 in addition to 120 out on the fields. Will get bids.
- Looking for bids for an electrician to install LED lights around the building for security. We may be able to receive funds from the Parks Department for Community Development.
- Would like to hire help to set up fields. Seth made a motion to hire up to 30 hours from American Workforce Group, Bob seconded, all in favor, motion passed.
- Work party to move goals with Kelso's help on Aug 29th.

Jak Massey, Head Registrar

- Coaches meeting this Thursday. Jeff will not be able to attend and Bob will be covering the info.

- Received word that CYSA is not going to do player cards any longer. Discussed issues with how to record player numbers on the roster. Suggested that the numbers are written legibly and then laminated.

- Uniforms have been ordered and paid for.
- Donated some retired shirts to a mission trip to Mexico.

- Parks and Rec asked for use of the U10 fields on Sundays and occasional Mondays and occasional Thursdays Sept. 22-Nov. 2 for a Men’s and Coed Tournament. It was agreed that we will ask \$25 per team for field use. They would have to coordinate with the Toney’s for field availability.
- Seth would like to put the AED in the equipment room and invite the trainer to come for Soccerpalooza.
- Signature cards are ready to go back to Fiber Federal.
