Called to order at 6:00

Jeff Coleman, President

- Reviewed August minutes. Jak made a motion to approve with the change of 60%, 40% to the CKC distribution. Seth seconded, all in favor, motion passed.

Marv Kasemeier, Concessions

- Made 250 hot dogs in 2.5 hours for Soccerpalooza. Did really well opening day. Sold out of water.
- The shack will be up and running this weekend.
- Umbrellas were more expensive than anticipated. Continuing to research and will get out some options soon.
- If accommodations can be made in either the concessions or the breezeway, ZoJo's is willing to allow volunteers to run their equipment and sell their coffee and will provide a volunteer in the beginning. Marv will be meeting with the owner tomorrow to discuss further.

Cathy Reynolds, Treasurer

- Reviewed August financials. Jak made a motion to approve, Seth seconded, all in favor, passed.
- CKC is not quite wrapped up.

Jak Massey, Head Registrar

- Update from last meeting: in lieu of player cards, Nicole Vasquez will gather player numbers from coaches and get them new, official rosters.
- Need to get something coordinated with Pam Fierst to work on birth certificates this season.
- Julie and Randy have some ideas about how to change up scheduling for Spring. They will be attending a future meeting to discuss them.
- Seth made a motion to allow 2 players late registration for U6 teams with a \$10 late fee. Tony seconded. Seth and Jennifer opposed. Motion passed.

Seth Cockrill, Facilities Manager, CYSA Vice President

- Purchased a new gator for \$1600 under budget. Recommended keeping the old gator until repair costs outweigh keeping it.
- Parts were stolen from the back-up reel cannon so we need to get some secure storage.

- Would like to purchase a wooden shed for storage in the back of the building. This would be more secure than open fencing and provide better, longer term storage for sprinklers and now the old Gator. Seth will get estimates.
- The fencing for the field 9 net is at Seth's house waiting for a time for someone to be able to help install it. Tentatively setting the 19th to get it done.
- Using sandbags for goal tie-downs now. They're working well.
- Stacie Harris has been hired as ref assignor has been hired for this season. CYSA will assume the full cost for this season.

Jenn Jolly, Equipment Manager

- Jersey handout went really well.
- There is a GU10 team that is likely using personal tournament uniforms rather than her issues jerseys. Jeff will follow up with the coach.
- Discussed going back to dri-fit jersey for U10 and up.

Tony Werner, CYSA Ref Liason, Micro-ref Coordinator

- About 20 kids in the micro-ref program.
- Soccerpalooza went really well. About 150 kids more than anticipated; about 400 kids.
- Exchanged field practice time with Kiffe's TB team to work the event.

Old business

- Longview Parks and Recreation had asked to use the fields for an adult tournament team. Scheduling has been an issue and it's come up that Park and Rec was planning on moving goals to create smaller fields when U10 aren't available. It was communicated that this cannot happen. It's now clear that Sundays are the only days available.

New business

- Oct. 16 we will have Mark Morris Varsity, R.A. Long Varsity and Jr. Varsity games at the same time. R.A. Long will start to have games on the fields.
- Jenn suggested some ideas for reducing the amount of printing required by coaches. We will brainstorm.
