Cathy Reynolds, Treasurer

- Received notice that the 501(c)3 was revoked as of May 1. However, it wasn't issued until July 1 so it's just a technicality that is under review. We should hear back within 30 days of receiving notice.
- Cathy attended a meeting with the state about a new rate structure for insurance fees. No decisions were made but something should happen by fall of 2015.
- Discussed the proposed new per player fee for each club to cover Bonzi fees, Ref Assignor, etc. The treasurers will work together to have a final 2015 budget ready for the November meeting.

Jak Massey, Head Registrar

- Registrars are having a meeting next Thursday to start preparing for the Spring season.
- Julie and Randy Toney asked Jak to present a few ideas to implement before the next season. They will be presented to CYSA.
- Jak strongly suggested that we do not offer High School bracket teams in the future. There are too many issues with schedules, field availability and player cards.
- Jak will bring a spring flyer for review to the November meeting.

Bob McIntyre, Vice President

- Incidents:
  - A grandfather was spoken to about his behavior towards a youth ref. He has not attended a game again.
  - A complaint was made against a Longview coach about his behavior during a game with a Castle Rock team. Bob will watch his next couple of games.
  - The jersey switching with a U16 and U18 coach was found to not have merit. There was another incident with the same coach concerning a ref that is under review.

Seth Cockrill, Field Maintenance

- Two high school students have been lining the fields and picking up garbage for community service hours.
- Field 9 still has some mole issues but he can't put mole traps on with the amount of games being played.
- There is a sprinkler head broken that needs fixed.
- The parks board would like someone to attend their next meeting to let them know about the shed. It will be explained that it's temporary and not a permanent structure.
- The restrooms are consistently unlocked and locked Mon-Sat. We continue to have issues with the restrooms not being unlocked on Sundays.
- CYSA would like to sell Timbers tickets at the concession stand.

- There are several high school games scheduled for Thursday. Seth needs help re-lining the fields as he won't have time to get them all done by Thursday. Bob and Jeff volunteered to do one each.

#### Marv Kasemeier, Concessions

- Sales have been low in the shack so they moved it out before it gets very wet.
- 7 Baristas have been trained and they are now selling ZoJo's coffee. They don't want any profits; we only have to purchase the supplies. We will start advertising.

#### Tony Werner, Micro Ref Coordinator

- 22 kids participating are participating in the youth ref program and it's going well.
- 20 keys were just issued to the refs so it may curb the restroom issues on Sundays.

#### Jenn Jolly, Equipment Manager

- Discussed ideas about how to implement silky jerseys again. Jenn will talk to Terry about the cost and logistics.
- Bob made a motion for jersey sizes to be added back into Bonzi, Tony seconded. Cathy, Jennifer, Jak, abstained until further information is gathered. Motion passed.
