

## Longview Soccer Club Minutes

November 10, 2014

Called to order at 6:01

Marv made a motion to approve October minutes, Bob seconded, all in favor, motion passed.

Cathy Reynolds, Treasurer

- Our 501c(3) has been reinstated.
- CKC funds have been dispersed.
- Youth refs have been paid. We will need to cut manual checks for the rest of the refs as CYSA is not currently equipped to pay through Arbitor.
- Jak made a motion to approve October financial, Seth seconded, all in favor, motion passed.
- CYSA has not yet presented a proposed 2015 budget. Cathy is supposed to receive something soon.

Bob McIntyre, Vice President

- Observed a Castle Rock game to follow up on a complaint against a Longview coach. Determined the coach is excitable but nothing of concern.
- Spoke to a BU15 coach and there won't be any issues as we aren't planning on offering high school divisions in the near future.
- Bob witnessed many teams not enforcing their spectators sitting on the opposite side of the fields. After discussion we decided to enforce the rule. Bob made a motion to require U6 and up spectators to sit on the opposite side of the field than the team, Marv seconded, all in favor, motion passed.

Jak Massey, Head Registrar

- At the recent CYSA Operations Committee meeting they discussed moving up the coaches meeting, needing a ref assignor by January, registration dates are Jan. 1 – Feb. 15.
- There is a Bonzi training scheduled on Nov. 18<sup>th</sup> hoping to bring in new volunteers.
- There is a proposal for just a coach's table during registration to sign up and an additional coach's only night.
- Walk-ins are scheduled for Jan. 17 10-2, Jan. 29 6-8, Feb. 7 10-2, Feb. 12 6-8.
- CYSA decided to do 6v6 for U12 and up for the spring on a U11 field. The registrar committee recommended waiting to see how the numbers looked before deciding. Jeff feels a decision needs to be made before. Jak made a motion that Longview supports 6v6 on the U11 fields for the Spring season unless there are enough players to form 9 teams between U12-14, Seth seconded, all in favor, Bob opposed, motion passed.
- Jak proposed a mandatory list of items for each club to be discussed at their coach's meeting.

- Reviewed the Spring flyer, Cathy made a motion to approve the flyer with a change to Spring, Jak seconded, all in favor, motion passed.

Seth Cockrill, Field Maintenance, CYSA Vice President

- Clean up day Nov. 22. Will send out an email to coaches to look for volunteers.
- Bob has a J.H. Kelly electrician that has volunteered his time to install lights. He will meet with Seth this week.
- Pro-line needs to come winterize the sprinklers.
- The shed is here and the pad needs to be prepared. There are some questions as to the placement allowed that Jeff will continue to work on.
- Seth needs to rent a spreader to re-seed.
- The Longview Parks and Rec adult league ran a week longer and the U10 field is in very bad shape.

Jeff Coleman, President

- Jeff presented Tony Werner's micro-ref report (attached).

Marv Kasemeier, Concessions

- Zojo's coffee was a success with each week improving on the last.
- Rented an umbrella \$10 up front with a \$5 return refund. Plan to do that again in the Spring.
- Will send Cathy additions to the menu for the Health Department permit.
- Will clean out the room this weekend.
- Cathy made a motion to have New Song return to run concessions for 2015, Jak seconded, all in favor, motion passed.
- Would like to explore a give-away to an entire team each Saturday as some sort of sportsmanship reward.

Old business

- Discussed the switch back to jerseys and the logistics of exact sizing for all shirts. We will wait until January to vote on limiting jerseys to sponsored teams.
- Jak made a motion to approve the banner to go over Nichol's Blvd. for approximately \$600, double sided, with dates for Spring and Fall, Cathy seconded, all in favor, motion passed.
- Discussed Challenger soccer camp returning in summer 2015. We decided to invite them back with no additional fees and we will ask for the week of June 22<sup>nd</sup>.
