Jim Maggs, Vice President

Discipline issue that needs to be addressed before registration is closed. This will likely need to be addressed in an Executive meeting due to the sensitivity of the issue.

To replace the commodes in the bathroom it would be too expensive so we'll look into cleaning them up and adjusting the water pressure. Getting quotes for hand dryers, painting floor, walls.

Initial quote was a total of \$9000.
